1. Read the clues

Let the mood catch your eye.

2. Choose your mystery

Pick a story without seeing its cover.

3. Unwrap & discover

Your next favorite might surprise you.

A little mystery. A whole new story.

YOUR STARTER PACK

1 / Print

This pack uses A4 paper. Print at 100% / Actual size.

Page 1: four black-and-white labels, each 3.4 x 4.5 inches.

Page 2: a display sign. Page 3: these instructions.

Use plain paper or full-sheet sticker paper. Cut out each label.

These are not aligned to precut label stock.

2 / Write the clues

Add two or three mood words under 'If you like...'.
Write a short hook under 'The teaser'. Leave out title and author.

Example: If you like... found family, secret doors, second chances.

The teaser: A quiet arrival turns an ordinary house upside down.

This is an invented example; choose clues that fit your actual book.

3 / Wrap and display

Cover the book with paper, attach a label, and set out the sign.

Add any useful age guidance or content notes before displaying.

For library books, keep the barcode accessible for checkout.
